The Meir Hanin International Aerospace Prize

The Faculty of Aerospace Engineering at the Technion announces the *Meir Hanin International Aerospace Prize* of 10,000 US\$ from the Hanin Endowment, in memory of the late Prof. Meir Hanin, who was a prominent scientist in theoretical aerodynamics and member of the Faculty of Aerospace Engineering from 1955 to 1999.

The prize is awarded once every two years for substantial scientific and/or technological achievements in aerospace sciences. Nominees from any country, regardless of religion, race, sex, or nationality, must have some association with the Technion and can only be nominated by the following: Technion faculty members, previous Hanin - Prize winners, members of the Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities, presidents and members of the Board of Institutes of Higher Learning, and CEO's of companies specializing in aerospace products.

Nominations, together with all relevant supporting material (CV, summary of major contributions and a letter supporting nomination), should be addressed to Prof. Itzhak Frankel, Dean of Aerospace Engineering, Technion – IIT, Haifa 32000, Israel (aedean@ae.technion.ac.il) by October 18th 2019.

The prize will be awarded in March 2020 at the Israel Annual Conference on Aerospace Sciences, which the winner is expected to personally attend and to give two public lectures, at the Technion and at the above conference.

(The Hanin Endowment will cover the winner's accommodation and travel expenses, up to 5000 US\$).
