The Meir Hanin International Aerospace Prize – Call for Nominations for 2026

The Stephen B. Klein Faculty of Aerospace Engineering at the Technion announces the Meir Hanin International Aerospace Prize of US \$10,000 from the Hanin Endowment, in memory of the late Prof. Meir Hanin, who was a prominent scientist in theoretical aerodynamics and a member of the Faculty of Aerospace Engineering from 1955 to 1999.

The prize is awarded once every two years for substantial scientific and/or technological achievements in aerospace sciences. Nominees from any country, must have some association with the Technion and can only be nominated by the following: Technion faculty members, previous Hanin Prize winners, members of the Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities, presidents and members of the Board of Institutes of Higher Learning, and CEO's of companies specializing in aerospace products.

Nominations, together with all relevant supporting material (CV, summary of significant contributions, and a supporting nomination letter), should be addressed to Prof. Daniella Raveh, Dean of the Stephen B. Klein Faculty of Aerospace Engineering, Technion – IIT, Haifa 32000, Israel (ae.dean.ad@technion.ac.il).

The prize will be awarded at a faculty ceremony, which the winner must personally attend. The winner is expected to give two public lectures at the Technion. The Hanin Endowment will cover the winner's accommodation and travel expenses up to US \$5,000.

Please submit candidate nominations to the Dean's Office by **October 31, 2025**.
