**Prize in Memory of Professor Arnan Seginer for Outstanding Excellence in Research –  
Call for Nominations for 2026**

As in previous years, this year Mrs. Ora Seginer and her daughters, Vered and Osnat, will award the Professor **Arnan Seginer Prize for Excellence in Research** at the faculty.

The prize for **Outstanding Excellence in Research** in the amount of **ILS 5,000** will be awarded to a student who has carried out praiseworthy work in the Research Project or Experimental Project courses in the faculty's undergraduate curriculum. This prize is donated by Mrs. Ora Seginer, Vered, and Osnat.

The prize for **Excellence in Research** in the amount of **ILS 3,000** will be awarded to a student who carried out excellent work on one of the above courses. The donor of this prize has chosen to remain anonymous.

The main criterion for selecting the prize recipients is “work that reflects Prof. Seginer's educational outlook toward excellence, creativity, coping with challenges and investigative thinking.” All students who took the Research Project course or Experimental Project course are eligible to submit their candidacy. Only in the event that it is difficult to choose between two excellent candidates, the Prize Committee will give preference to a candidate who is continuing as postgraduate to pursue a master's degree in the faculty.

Proposals should include the final report of the work the student submitted on the Research Project course or Experimental Project course and a letter of recommendation from the project supervisor.

Please submit candidate nominations to the Dean's Office by **March 1, 2026**.

The prize will be granted at a faculty ceremony for outstanding students, attended by representatives of the family, to be held on July 1, 2026.
