The prize is intended for outstanding students or faculty members in the Faculty of Aerospace Engineering who integrate piano playing or playing another musical instrument in their studies/research, with preference given to classical music.

The prize is awarded to faculty members or students at the undergraduate or graduate level according to the following criteria:

- a. For an innovative invention in the field of aeronautics.
- b. For outstanding research work or commendable excellence in their studies at the faculty.
- c. For excellence in playing a musical instrument.


Prize amount: **ILS 2,000.**

Proposals must include: Summary of nominee's CV, short description of nominee's musical activities, grade transcript (for students), letters of recommendations, research work (if any) and/or documentation of innovative invention. Recommendations from the field of music are highly recommended.

Please submit candidate nominations to the Dean's Office by **March 1, 2026.**

The prize will be awarded at the faculty ceremony for outstanding students, to be held on July 1, 2026.
